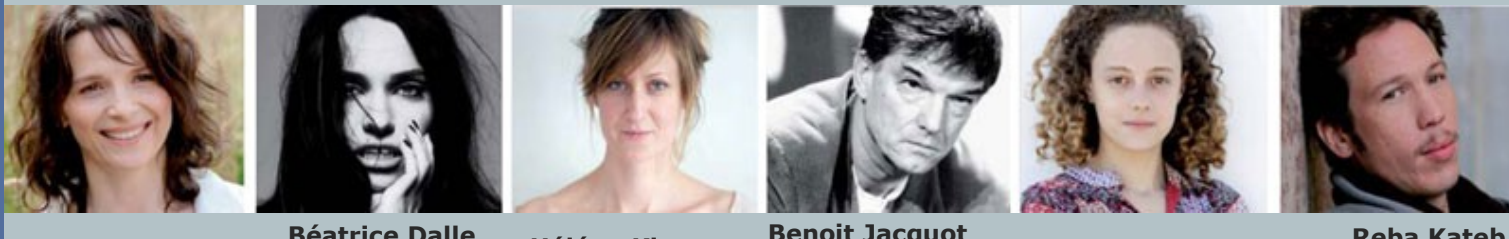

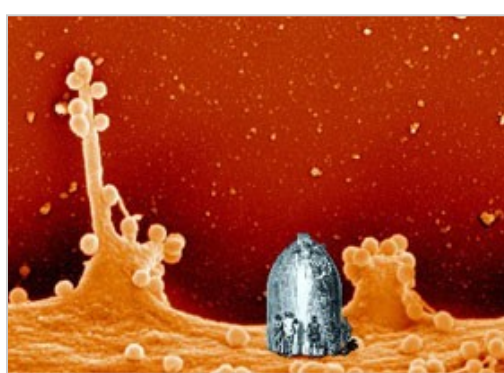

EXHIBITION "SCIENCE/FICTION: A JOURNEY IN THE HEART OF LIFE "

1-30 NOVEMBER 2012

The French Embassy in Ireland, in partnership with the Institute of Technology Tallaght presents the exhibition **"Science/Fiction: a journey in the heart of life"** for the full month of November 2012. From living organisms, observed at the **microscopic level**. And from the work of France's most visionary writer, **Jules Verne**. The panels on display are a superimposition of scientific photographs from the **Inserm** image bank and **old engravings** illustrating the writings of Jules Verne. 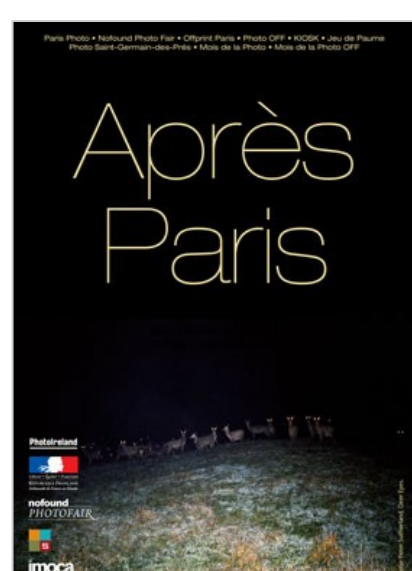
